BREEDERS PLATE RACE 2027

1. All entrants into the Bundaberg Racing Pigeon Club Inc Breeders Plate Race agree to be bound by the conditions set out below.
2. This race will be flown under the auspices and management of the BRPC Inc.
3. The race will be flown from a race point on the 2027 schedule approximately 300-350 miles distance measured from the Bundaberg City GPO
4. The BRPC Inc Breeders Plate is open to any breeder within the BRPC Inc boundary which is a 50km radius from the Bundaberg City GPO, out of boundary breeders are welcome to enter birds, but must partner with flyers within the boundary, a maximum of (5) five birds can be placed in any one flyers loft, the nominated flyers name is to be on the official entry form, any prize money won in this circumstance will be paid to the flyer only, and the breeder and flyer should have their own agreement on how any winnings will be split.
5. Entries must be on a BRPC Inc official entry form and will be available from the club website pigeonrace.net, two copies of the form must be provided when entering and paying for the birds, the BRPC Inc do not require that the bird be brought to the clubhouse, but breeders/flyers need to **ensure** the correct life ring number and bird colour is on the entry form as this **cannot** be changed once the forms are signed by the treasurer and the flyer, the club result system verifies this when entering the bird data, if the colour does not match with the life ring the bird will be disqualified.
6. Non-member flyers are to provide to the BRPC Inc their loft coordinates, which will be verified for accuracy by the calculation committee chairperson, any discrepancies will be communicated to the flyer in question.
7. All bird entries must be rung with a recognised life ring with a prefix 2026 and be the registered property of the breeder, international rings will not be allowed.

8. The BRPC Inc reserves the right to complete a homing verification on any prize winners, this will consist of removing the bird from the loft and taking it at least 100 metres out of sight of the loft and releasing it, the bird will be monitored for returning to the flyers loft.
9. Non-member flyers are welcome to send their entries on the BRPC Inc transporter on race days for training purposes if they desire, at a cost of \$1.00 per bird per toss, training entry forms will be available on the club website pigeonrace.net and must be given to the club treasurer when paying for the training toss.
10. Entry fee will be \$20.00 per bird, with a maximum entry of 20 birds, race entries close on 6th December 2026.
11. Prize money breakdown
 - 6th Place divide total prize money by 21
 - 5th Place divide total prize money by 15
 - 4th Place divide total prize money by 10
 - 3rd Place divide total prize money by 6
 - 2nd Place divide total prize money by 3
 - 1st Place Balance of remaining monies
12. The Breeders Plate Race will be a **Multiple Trap Event**
13. **NO** BRPC Inc club championship points will be awarded for this race
