SIRES PRODUCE RACE 2027

1. All entrants into the Bundaberg Racing Pigeon Club Inc Sires Produce Race agree to be bound by the conditions set out below.
2. This race will be flown under the auspices and management of the BRPC Inc.
3. Any person is eligible to participate in the auctions and may purchase birds to be flown by a nominated flyer who resides within the boundary of the BRPC Inc, all auctions will be held at the clubhouse located in Skyring Street Bundaberg unless otherwise advised, auction dates to be published on the club's website pigeonrace.net in advance.
4. The race will be flown from a race point on the 2027 schedule approximately 300-350 miles distance measured from the Bundaberg GPO
5. All non-members entering birds will be limited to 25 birds only over the course of all auctions.
6. All birds entered for the auction are to be fully feathered under the wings and able to fend for themselves, birds must not have cast more than one flight in each wing to be eligible for entry into the auction, the BRPC Inc reserves the right to refuse entry of any bird.
7. Entries must be on a BRPC Inc official entry form which will be available on the club website pigeonrace.net, two copies of the form must accompany the entries on auction day and be handed to the Ring Secretary or their delegate.

8. Breeders need to **ensure** the correct life ring number and bird colour is on the entry form as this **cannot** be changed once the forms are signed by the Ring Secretary and the breeder or their delegate, Nominated flyers are required to verify the purchases for ring ID and colour on the day of purchase and any discrepancies are to be brought to the attention of the Ring Secretary or their delegate, the club result system cross references and verifies this when entering bird data, if the colour does not match with the life ring the bird will be disqualified.
9. All bird entries must be rung with a recognised life ring with prefix 2026 and be the registered property of the breeder, once the bird is purchased the breeder relinquishes all rights to ownership of the said bird, the BRPC Inc ring secretary will automatically register the bird as the property of the nominated flyer as under the BRPC Inc rules the bird must be the property of the flyer.
10. All entries are to be at the auction site no later than 09.30am on the day of auction, late entries will not be accepted, auction start time to be 10.00am.
11. Birds purchased at the auction must be paid for within fourteen (14) days post auction day, any person not complying without good reason shall be deemed unfinancial and prevented from participating in further auctions until financial again, any birds not fully paid for will not be eligible to compete in the race.
12. Opening bids will be \$20.00, if a bird reaches a \$100.00 bid the buyer will get a free bird into the race, with a free bird for any further \$100.00 reached ie \$200.00 bid another free bird into the race (total of 3 birds) and so on, any free birds will have to meet the criteria of entry in rule 6, if no bids are gained the bird will be passed in and the breeder notified of such.
13. The Bundaberg Racing Pigeon Club Inc will reserve the right to deduct 10% of all auction monies raised to cover administration and service costs. Remaining prize money will be divided into six (6) places and split into the following categories.
 - a. Breeder-30%
 - b. Buyer-20%
 - c. Flyer-50%

14. Prize money breakdown

- 6th Place divide total prize money by 21
- 5th Place divide total prize money by 15
- 4th Place divide total prize money by 10
- 3rd Place divide total prize money by 6
- 2nd Place divide total prize money by 3
- 1st Place Balance of remaining monies

15. The Sires Produce Race will be a **Multiple Trap Event**

- 16. Non-member flyers are to provide to the BRPC Inc their loft coordinates, which will be verified for accuracy by the calculation committee chairperson, any discrepancies will be communicated to the flyer in question.
- 17. Non-member flyers are welcome to send their entries on the BRPC Inc transporter on race days for training purposes if they desire, at a cost of \$1.00 per bird per toss, training entry forms will be available on the club website and must be given to the club treasurer when paying for the training toss.
- 18. All birds purchased must be (health permitting) given every opportunity to compete in the race this means flying out, road training and have race conditioning, any flyer failing to comply will be asked to **explain** the reasons behind any decision not to send birds to the race.
- 19. The BRPC Inc reserves the right to complete a homing verification on any prize winners, this will consist of removing the bird from the loft and taking it at least 100 metres out of sight of the loft and releasing it, the bird will be monitored for returning to the flyers loft.
