2024 SYDNEY SUPER SERIES

Introduction

After a good start in 2023, this unique initiative providing an opportunity for flyers to participate for good prizemoney each week for 10 weeks, IS ON AGAIN.

All current CCF flyers within the boundary are eligible to enter.

The races will be conducted under CCF racing rules and all decisions will be made by the organisers, without appeal.

The following guidelines apply:

- 1 One team only from one address. The limit per team will be the current CCF limit and will be same team entered into the scheduled CCF race.
- 2 Prizemoney will be on the basis on a minimum entry of 20 teams, in accordance with the following: 1st 70%

2nd 20%

3rd 10%

For example, if 20 teams enter, prizemoney will be 1st \$7,000, 2nd \$2,000 and 3rd \$1,000 each week! More teams, more prizemoney!

THE SERIES REQUIRES A MINIMUM OF 20 ENTRIES TO PROCEED.

Syndicates can be formed flying from one address.

ALL entry fees collected will be paid out in prizemoney.

- 3 Cost per team is \$5,000 for the 10 race series. Entry fee will be required with your nomination before the first race of the CCF season, 1st Marulan.
- 4 The Series will commence from Thursday night basketing 1st Rutherglen and end 2nd Bendigo, including Hamilton. In the event of a cancelled race, prizemoney will be allocated to the remaining races.
- 5 The CCF website will be used to determine results. Weekly prize winners must hand a copy of the race entry sheet and the race result printout in to the Seven Hills Pigeon Club representative at the Fairfield basketing centre the following week.
- 6 Prizemoney will be paid out on a weekly basis.
