



Recommendations to Clubs for COVID – 19 Racing Protocols Basketing and Clock Ring Off

- Clubs are responsible to ensure that appropriate measures are in place to protect members – **The Federation is not responsible to ensure protocols are in place**
- Social distancing is to be practiced – 1.5 metres apart
- Members are to comply with all Government regulations covering social distancing
- Hand sanitizer and hand soap should always be available
- Club canteens should be closed and food not available within the Club premises
- Basketing times should be staggered to ensure no gatherings
- Do not congregate at the Club after basketing and clock ring off night Saturday
- Designate members to operate the clocking system, handle the birds and scrutineer
- Members should remain in their vehicle until called to basket their birds and clock reading night
- Social distancing should be considered when travelling to the loading point (unless a family member is travelling with the driver) Two vehicles may be required
- Ensure proper PPE is in place when loading, returning, and cleaning baskets
