BUSINESS ARISING:

Liberation Committee:

- 1. The President, Phil Murphy, had been advised that members of the Liberation Committee had received various phone calls and text messages following the decision to basket last Thursday for a Friday race.
- 2. One of the Liberation Committee members, Dave Gordon, said that he had received a text with abusive language toward himself and others.
- 3. A similar incident had occurred in the 2020 season, and it was moved that a letter be sent to the member concerned advising that this would not be tolerated. Carried.
- 4. Any further incidents will result in possible suspension of flying and or membership.

Tossing:

- 1. The toss this weekend (26th of June) will be conducted from Redhead.
- 2. It was moved that liberation time be set at 9.00am, which will allow most birds to be home long before the race birds from Tea Gardens. Carried.
- 3. The following week, tossing will resume from Tea Gardens, if there is sufficient support.
- 4. If not, Redhead will be considered.
- 5. Tossing will continue after the five-week program, if supported by the members.

Liberator:

- 1. The President advised that the Liberator, Tony Farrugia, had resigned and that Thomas Attard, the current truck driver would take over as Liberator in the short term.
- 2. An additional driver has been hired while the Federation has two (2) vehicles going to the race point.
- 3. Following this, a new liberator will be hired.

Collection of Strays:
