- **It was agreed in 2019, we fly the west route from Yunta in South Australia, an approximate distance of 660 to 700 miles. The date proposed is the weekend of 7+8/9/19, basketing on Tuesday 3/9/19, liberation on Friday 6/9/19.**
- The entry cost will \$10.00 per bird, no limit on how many birds a flyer can send.
- **Flyers are to nominate their interest 1 month prior to the race date and confirm 2 weeks prior to allow for baskets to be allocated and delivered to the basketing centres.**
- Prize Cards will be awarded to the top 50 birds overall, as well as prize cards for sectional winners, each Flyer can trap 2 birds.
- **A fundraising auction will be held on Tim Faucett web site to help support the new club. Starting on 20/05/19. Please contact if you wish to donate a bird.**
- Each Fed/section will contribute a % of the entry fee to the overall prize pool. The delegates from each area, are encouraged to seek out sponsorship for both sectional and the overall prize pools, this will assist in subsidising the overall cost to flyers and increase the prize pool.
