He advised that since his previous proposal there have been a number of changes that require all carry boxes to be made out of timber to comply with the new regulations.

He advised that he felt that we should look at this options as it is far better for the birds as they can be at the race point, ready for release within 24 hours, as opposed to 3 days transport via

the truck. He advised that he will send in an estimate of what he believes the air freight cost will be in due course.

The Chair acknowledged that this option will no doubt reduce the stress on the birds and that this has been done before, but the issue is however arranging someone at the other end to collect, look after and liberate the birds.
