Terms & Conditions

- Race point is Harwood NSW currently planned for Saturday 2nd June 2018 an approximate distance of 230km.
 Basketing will be on the Friday prior at 7pm Zammit Oval, Deception Bay.
- 2. Race conditions are as per NRC rules.
- 3. Open to the North Road Club only.
- 4. Eligible lofts must be located North of the Brisbane River and South of the 'Big Fish'. An application for exemption can be made for consideration.
- Liberation will be determined by the NRC Liberation Committee. If conditions are not ideal, preference is for a holdover or cancellation but not a change in location / distance.
- 6. Liberation will be a separate release 10 minutes after the Combine release.
- 7. Total prize money awarded to the first 2 positions will be 1st 70%, 2nd 30%. Total prize money and payout amounts are determined by the number of paid up entries
- 8. All prize money birds must be made available on request for inspection and / or tossing at the competitor's declared loft location by designated committee members (or appointee/s) after a provisional result is declared. If either of / or both of these two conditions is not met, the bird is disqualified.
- The 1st prize winner/s must make themselves available for interview/s for media purposes and to promote the race and sport before prize money is provided.

- 10. Teams (of two (2)) will consist of; the flyer leading the overall points score as at the previous week with the flyer trailing the overall points score; the runner up flyer in the points score with the second-to-last and so on.
- 11. PMV inoculation is not required.
- 12. The requirement for ROTA immunisation is yet to be determined.
- 13. Limit of one prize per team.
- 14. Entry is \$20 per team.
- 15. Limit of two (2) entries per flyer per team.
- 16. Entries count toward a flyers 25 bird limit
- 17. The result will be determined by adding the velocity of the best bird (of the two (2) entries) from each team member.
- 18. Entries are only valid upon payment.
- 19. Entries are only valid on nomination (to the race secretary) on basketing night.
- 20. Race co-ordinates are to be verified.
- 21. The administration of drugs to racing pigeons with the purpose of enhancing race performance is not permitted. The committee at its discretion may arrange for testing to determine if drugs are being used. Prize money will be paid upon a negative result.
- 22. Clocking may be by either electronic or manual means.
- 23. No qualifying races are required but are recommended by the NRC Inc.
- 24. By entering the race you are considered to have accepted all of the NRC Salary Cap Race terms and conditions.
