Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

Minutes of the previous meeting 8th July 2017 were read.

Updates;

a) Dot Point (c) Access to North Road Combine Facebook site – still not yet granted.

The 'North Road Combine' is now trademarked (this is for 10 years). This allows us to use the ® which you will see on all our Letterheads and Paperwork from now on and makes the use of 'North Road Combine' illegal by anyone other than ourselves. This also makes it very simple for compensation and automatic recovery of legal costs.

Recommendation (10);

An Intellectual Property Attorney be hired to facilitate either the handover or the closing down of the North Road Combine Facebook Page and immediately seek compensation for the use of our trademark. (Given that the individual/s in question read our meeting minutes I would expect this to happen within days or we will immediately seek compensation plus legal costs from the individual/s.)

At the AGM 26th February 2017 a motion was passed that the President and Treasurer be given honorariums of \$100 each; there is no flexibility for the NRC to reduce Nathan's fees while maintaining fairness to all; both the President and Treasurer have decided to sponsor Nathan to the tune of the above amount of \$200.

This (President / Treasurer) Sponsorship Initiative will be maintained into the foreseeable future.

b) Letter from Gateway Club (previously not tabled (reasons unknown – 2015/16))

Summary;

To address the loss of membership:

- a) Change in direction this has been addressed.
- b) On a trial basis a breaking point be investigated seeking a palatable solution to the membership due to the disadvantage introduced by the unique S/E QLD geography of the ranges and coastline.

Business Arising;

- 1) At least one (1) but a number of Invitation / Novelty races be offered flying with a Breaking Point (at Reedy Creek, Gold Coast). That allows Flyers / Competitors to either opt in or out at their discretion.
 - The following artefacts are required from pro-supporters to allow an informed decision by Members;
- 2) Post processing of a number of examples from both the North and South Routes of races re-calculated using the Breaking Point for analysis of lofts located to the West / Central and to the East of the boundaries.
- 3) A second results page be run and updated in / on a timely basis for the upcoming season in parallel with the standard velocity calculation/s and results page.

c) Letter from Walter Bore

Summary;

- a) Boundaries be enforced will be addressed in the (currently in draft) Flying Rules.
- b) Prize money to be retained within the NRC Club will be addressed under specific Invitation / Novelty Race Terms and Conditions (some Races / Prize Money and Pools will be Club only, others Sectional and the remainder Combine a mix and / or combinations will be available) and also addressed shortly under General Business (at this meeting).
- c) Electronic Clocks be mandated for higher prize money races (manual clocks can still be used for Club only racing) this will also be addressed under specific Invitation / Novelty Race Terms and Conditions.

- d) Club to purchase an EBS to facilitate transition (flyer to purchase the pad) deferred.
- d) Letter from ANRPB Motion that Joe Jackson is endorsed as the QLD representative of the ANRPB.

No additional business arose from the inward correspondence.

There was no outward correspondence tabled.

It was noted that a freedom of information request will be made to the Office of Fair Trading for all receipts for the North Road Combine for the past 5 years.

No additional business arose from outward correspondence.

Minutes of the Previous Committee Meeting:

The Secretary read the minutes of the recently convened Management Committee meeting 17 August 2017, at Zammit Oval and made the following recommendations to the Membership for a vote;

Recommendation (1);

A Ring Race is to be run (at \$40 per ring) in place of the Breeders Plate for this year (only) and (after stability) the reintroduction of the Breeder's Plate will be referred to the membership next year. Specially allocated rings will be sold for the event. At the purchase of rings the flyer is to be nominated. No limit on the number of rings purchased. Bird limits will apply for basketing on day (the same as the Grizzle Race this year) i.e. if 15 Ring Race birds are presented for the race (the 25 bird basketing limit applies), this leaves 10 birds able to be presented for the club race.

Available to the same boundary as Breeder's Plate – Brisbane River to the South and 'The Fish' to the North. [Note* this is a different North boundary than recorded in the Breeder's Plate Terms and Conditions; South of Roy's Road / Kilcoy – Beerwah Road]

Distance to be around the 600km / 400nm mark.

Prize Money to be distributed: - Breeder 50% Flyer 50%

Moved Neal Rose Seconded Joe Reeves.

Unanimous, Carried.

Recommendation (2);

A 25 bird (basketing) limit applies from now onward which applies to all Clubs and Affiliates. This conforms to the RSPCA basketing guideline/s.

Baskets and numbers will be allocated and the condition of the crates is the responsibility of the host club. Replacement cost per crate will be \$125

Recommendation (5);

Schedule after Morven – Rest week / Quilpie (875km release EAP (6-6:15am) Fri) drive back to Charleville (680km and wait until the next day (planned for Saturday)) on the same weekend (anticipated release EAP).

*Note – thought to be given next year to releasing at the shorter of the two release points, then drives onto the longer release point and wait the Lib and Transportation Guidelines timeframe releasing later in the morning (this means the birds will have a shorter time until last light)

Discussion (4);

Next year's schedule (for draft refer web site) – deferred due time constraints.

Note/s*- Ballina too far for first race & consideration to be given to the first race point (being used as an educational release) and not as an official race; where members are invited to send as many birds as they wish and private tosses (up with the mass) with the transporter are encouraged.

Reference Bega / Moruya / Appin – the belief is that there will be too few birds left (by this stage) given the proposed schedule.

Remove Appin, keep the 1 x Forresters Beach; move the Futurity to Red Head; Moruya and Bega are on a challenging road and suggest that these release points be moved to (Camden) Marulan and Goulburn.

Note* Bateman's Bay the birds were hit almost before they got out of the truck.

Discussion (5);

Refer to numerous previous Liberation reports the temperature in truck is often in single digits (too low) – deferred due time constraints. Comment was made reference the lower overnight temperatures to the West compared to those on the Coast. [Note* the temperature recorded for Roma at 12:15pm was 22.7 degrees and at 5am was 17 degrees]

Discussion (6);

Constitutional changes / Special Resolutions require 75% of the vote to pass.

a) The name of the Classes of membership be amended from; Ordinary to Flying and; Associate to Social

The Constitution currently reads; (2) The management committee has authority to interpret the meaning of rules and any matter relating to the association on which the rules are silent, but any interpretation must have regard to the Act, including any regulation made under the Act.

Suggested change; (2)and any matter relating to the association on which the rules are silent is to be decided by the majority of votes of the members present at the next general meeting.....

j) Acceptance or Rejection of Membership Application be amended;

The Constitution currently reads; (3) The management committee must decide at the meeting whether to accept or reject the application.

Suggested change; (3) The membership must decide at the meeting whether to accept or reject the application.

Moved David Christensen Seconded Vicki Wilkinson Unanimous. Carried.

k) The Objects of the Association be amended from; To Race Pigeons to; to promote the hobby of breeding and engage in the friendly competition of racing Pigeons and to foster a positive social environment for members, affiliates and their families. Competition is for Testing Pigeons, not Relationships"

- 7) Draft for comment Code of Conduct is available on the web page which is suggested as a condition of membership application and renewal deferred
- 8) Draft for comment Liberation Guideline is available on the web page which is suggested as a condition of membership application and renewal deferred
- 9) Requirement for a contract / agreement with affiliates for cartage, flying rules and tossing deferred. Flying Rule (in draft)

Rules exist for the NRC (Club) but not between the NRC and affiliate clubs (Combine). Note* crate allocation and care and replacement cost of \$125 to be included.

10) There has been a spike in the requirement for running repairs (dowels broken and frames cracked) to the crates. Appeal to members that if a crate is removed from the premises that it is appropriately cared for; please don't leave them loose in the back of Utes or in trailers and please be careful when tying them down.

11) Refund to affiliate members (\$50) - complete / Membership / Voting Rights. Refer to Discussion Point (6) where suggested constitutional changes are required – deferred

To become a member of the NRC; be located within the defined boundaries of the NRC; fill out membership application; sponsored my existing membership; accepted by membership.

Constitutional changes required – by way of an additional layer of membership called for e.g. out of area members.

- 12) The committee has an expectation that when the club runs really well members will start to put their hands up more and we are starting to see this. New philosophy is 'What is your job?' What is your job?' The committee encourages everybody to make a contribution to the overall workload to enable the club to function by volunteering for at least one job and learn at least a second.
- 16) A motion was put forward from the floor and the rank and file adopted and unanimously passed the motion for a show cause to the 'x' Committee deferred
- 17) The tradition of a Presentation Night continue with a volunteer required to run the event and a volunteer to produce a summarised laminated sheet of Flyer results to be presented. Bob Holloway volunteered to organise the Night (as he has done a number of these in the past, but required a Master of Ceremonies—thanks Bob.
- 18) Would anyone like to take the production of the End of Year Book on?? Comments for the floor indicated that the End of Year book was simply a copy of race results that were available on the net and saw little point is the effort in its production.
- 19) Peter Matthew's has been approached and request permission that his articles be available on the web site and take on the role of publicity officer.
- 20) Role Definition/s functional mapping so the appropriate person can be contacted to answer any questions deferred. This will form part of the (currently in draft) Flying Rules.
- 21) Thought is to be given to Succession Planning to train at least a second person to understand your role.

22) Club to purchase Eprinex (5 litre to be purchased and split into 100ml) – for Pigeon Fly / Lice. Keep an eye out for suitable bottles for distribution. Dennis Martens can purchase the product cheaply.
