



# Any Other Colour Classic

## Terms & Conditions

1. Race point is Crescent Head NSW currently planned for Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2018 an approximate distance of 425km. Basking will be on the Friday prior at 6pm Zammit Oval, Deception Bay.
2. Race conditions are as per NRC rules.
3. Open to the North Road Club only.
4. Eligible lofts must be located North of the Brisbane River and South of the 'Big Fish'. An application for exemption can be made for consideration.
5. Coloured birds may only be entered. Coloured birds are defined as all birds other than normal standard colour / pattern birds. Birds **not** permitted are Light, Blue, Dark and Black Chequers and Blue Bars unless Pies. Pies are defined as any bird with a white flight or white main tail feather or any bird with a white area the size of a 10 cent piece or greater (in the same position), excluding the rumps, socks, undercarriage and wing / tail **cover** feathers. Birds with tick eyes are not classed as pies.
6. The Race Secretary shall determine the eligibility of a bird for inclusion.
7. Where it is found that an ineligible bird has been entered in the AOC race, the fees paid for entry to the pool will be refunded to the competitor and the race awarded to the AOC race bird with the next highest recorded velocity.
8. Liberation will be determined by the NRC Liberation Committee. If conditions are not ideal, preference is for a holdover or cancellation but not a change in location / distance.
9. Liberation will be a mass release along with the scheduled Combine release.
10. Total prize money awarded to the first 3 positions will be 1<sup>st</sup> 60%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30% and 3<sup>rd</sup> 10%. Total prize money and payout amounts are determined by the number of paid up entries.
11. PMV inoculation is not required.
12. The requirement for ROTA immunisation is yet to be determined.
13. All prize money birds must be made available on request for inspection and / or tossing at the competitor's declared loft location by designated committee members (or appointee/s) after a provisional result is declared. If either of / or both of these two conditions is not met, the bird is disqualified.
14. The 1<sup>st</sup> prize winner/s must make themselves available for interviews for media purposes and to promote the race and sport before prize money is provided.
15. Limit of one prize flyer.
16. Entry is \$5 per bird
17. Limit of one (1) entry per fully paid up flyer.
18. Entries count toward a flyers 25 bird limit.
19. Entries are only valid upon payment.
20. Race co-ordinates are to be verified.
21. The administration of drugs to racing pigeons with the purpose of enhancing race performance is not permitted. The committee at its discretion may arrange for testing to determine if drugs are being used. Prize money will be paid upon a negative result.
22. Clocking may be by either electronic or manual means.
23. No qualifying races are required but are recommended by the NRC Inc.
24. By entering the AOC race you are considered to have accepted all of the NRC Any Other Colour Classic terms and conditions.
