



Ranga Race

Terms & Conditions

1. Race point is Ballina NSW currently planned for Saturday 19th May 2018 an approximate distance of 169km. Basketing will be on the Friday prior at 7pm Zammit Oval, Deception Bay.
2. Race conditions are as per NRC rules.
3. Open to the North Road Club only.
4. Eligible lofts must be located North of the Brisbane River and South of the 'Big Fish'. An application for exemption can be made for consideration.
5. Red birds may only be entered. Red birds include the following (including peds of) Red Chequer, Yellow Chequer, Mealy, Cream, Yellow, Red, Browns, Dunn and Red Grizzles
6. The Race Secretary shall determine the eligibility of a bird for inclusion.
7. Where it is found that an ineligible bird has been entered in the Ranga race, the fees paid for entry to the pool will be refunded to the competitor and the race awarded to the red race bird with the next highest recorded velocity.
8. Liberation will be determined by the NRC Liberation Committee. If conditions are not ideal, preference is for a holdover or cancellation but not a change in location / distance.
9. Liberation will be a mass release along with the scheduled Combine release.
10. Total prize money awarded to the first 3 positions will be 1st 60%, 2nd 30% and 3rd 10%. Total prize money and payout amounts are determined by the number of paid up entries.
11. PMV inoculation is not required.
12. The requirement for ROTA immunisation is yet to be determined.
13. All prize money birds must be made available on request for inspection and / or tossing at the competitor's declared loft location by designated committee members (or appointee/s) after a provisional result is declared. If either of / or both of these two conditions is not met, the bird is disqualified.
14. The 1st prize winner/s must make themselves available for interviews for media purposes and to promote the race and sport before prize money is provided.
15. Limit of one prize flyer.
16. Entry is \$5 per bird
17. Limit of three (3) entries per fully paid up flyer.
18. Entries count toward a flyers 25 bird limit.
19. Entries are only valid upon payment.
20. Race co-ordinates are to be verified.
21. The administration of drugs to racing pigeons with the purpose of enhancing race performance is not permitted. The committee at its discretion may arrange for testing to determine if drugs are being used. Prize money will be paid upon a negative result.
22. Clocking may be by either electronic or manual means.
23. No qualifying races are required but are recommended by the NRC Inc.
24. By entering the race you are considered to have accepted all of the NRC Ranga Race terms and conditions.
