



2021 – (Club) Ladies Race

Terms & Conditions

Sponsored by Robin White Gas Fitting - 0418 121 337

1. Race point is Agnes Waters QLD. Currently planned for Saturday 17th July 2021, an approximate distance of 350km. Basketing will be on the Friday prior at 7pm - Zammit Oval, Deception Bay.
2. Race conditions are as per NRC Flying Rules.
3. Open to the North Road Club only.
4. Eligible lofts must be located North of the Brisbane River and South of the 'Big Fish'. An application for exemption can be made for consideration.
5. Liberation will be determined by the NRC Liberation Committee. If conditions are not ideal, preference is for a holdover or cancellation but not a change in location / distance.
6. Liberation will be a mass release along with the scheduled Combine release.
7. Total prize money awarded to the first four (4) positions will be;
 - 1st 40%
 - 2nd 30%
 - 3rd 20% and
 - 4th 10%
8. Total prize money and payout amounts are determined by sponsorship and the number of paid up entries.
9. PMV inoculation is not required.
10. ROTA inoculation is not required.
11. All prize money birds must be made available on request for inspection and / or tossing at the competitor's declared loft location by designated committee members (or appointee/s) after a provisional result is declared. If either of / or both of these two (2) conditions are not met, the bird is disqualified.
12. The 1st prize winner/s (+ lady) must make themselves available for interviews for media purposes and to promote the race and sport before prize money is provided.
13. Limit of two (2) entries per lady (pseudo flyer).
14. Entry is \$5 per bird.
15. Limit of one (1) prize per lady (pseudo flyer).
16. No limit of entries per fully paid up flyer. For example - a single loft location could have 5 ladies entered with 2 birds each. I.e. a total of 10 birds in the race at a single loft.
17. Entries count toward the actual flyers Twenty-five (25) bird limit.
18. Entries are only valid upon full payment.
19. Entries are only valid on nomination (to the race secretary) on basketing night.
20. The philosophy of the race is to involve / include more women and girls in the sport therefore **entries are only valid on the condition the nominated lady attends clock reading and provisional result declaration.**
21. Race co-ordinates are to be verified.
22. The administration of drugs to racing pigeons with the purpose of enhancing race performance is not permitted. The committee at its discretion may arrange for testing to determine if drugs are being used. Prize money will be paid upon a negative result.
23. Clocking may be by either electronic or manual means.
24. No qualifying races are required but are recommended by the NRC Inc.
25. By entering the race you are considered to have accepted all of the NRC Flying Rules and NRC Club Ladies Race terms and conditions.
