



Recycled Teenagers – Bay to Brisbane

Terms & Conditions

In honour of founding member Dave Hazelwood

1. Race point is Hervey Bay QLD. Currently planned for Saturday 19th June 2021, an approximate distance of 210km. Baskinging will be on the Friday prior at 7pm - at the various designated baskinging centres (subject to change).
2. Race conditions are as per NRC Flying Rules.
3. Open to all fully paid Flying members and affiliates of the North Road Combine (NRC).
4. Eligible lofts must be located within the above's (2017) designated boundaries.
5. Liberation will be determined by the NRC Liberation Committee. If conditions are not ideal, preference is for a holdover or cancellation but not a change in location / distance.
6. Liberation will be a mass release along with the scheduled combine release.
7. Total prize money awarded to the first 3 positions will be (by sponsorship) an available pool of;
 - 1st - \$1,000,
 - 2nd - \$500 and
 - 3rd - \$250.
8. Total prize payout amounts are determined as a percentage of the available place prize pools;
 - 10% if the flyers membership deposit was paid prior to the last day of October; plus
 - 30% non-continuous flyers (i.e. those returning in 2021 after a break from Flying membership) with the NRC; or
 - the previous 30% plus an additional 30% for continuous two (2) year plus flyers with the NRC; plus
 - 30% if the flyers affiliated / registered club underwrites / coordinates sponsorship of a \$1,000 novelty / sponsored race for the 2021 season
9. All prize money birds must be made available on request for inspection and / or tossing at the competitor's declared loft location by designated committee members (or appointee/s) after a provisional result is declared. If either of / or both of these (2) two conditions are not met, the bird is disqualified.
10. PMV inoculation is not required.
11. ROTA inoculation is not required.
12. The 1st prize winner/s must make themselves available for interview/s for media purposes and to promote the race and sport before prize money is provided.
13. Birds are to be 2019 or earlier rung (Old birds)
14. Limit of twenty-five (25) entries per fully paid up flyer.
15. Entries count toward a flyers twenty-five (25) bird limit.
16. Limit of one (1) prize per fully paid up flyer.
17. Entry is \$10 per bird or a discounted \$100 per team.
18. Entries are only valid upon payment on baskinging night.
19. Entries are only valid on nomination (to the relevant race secretary(s)) on baskinging night.
20. Nominations are only valid (after on-forwarding by the various representative secretaries and) if received by the NRC Race Secretary (8 hours) prior to release of the birds.
21. Any club that accepts nomination shall be responsible for all fees / dues. The said club shall bear all losses if the member/s fail/s to become fully financial.
22. Race co-ordinates are to be verified.
23. The administration of drugs to racing pigeons with the purpose of enhancing race performance is not permitted. The committee at its discretion may arrange for testing to determine if drugs are being used. Prize money will be paid upon a negative result.
24. Clocking may be by either electronic or manual means.
25. By entering the race you are considered to have accepted all of the NRC Flying Rules and Recycled Teenager Bay to Brisbane terms and conditions.
