<u>President's Report</u>; Wayne gives a President's Report every basketing night as he feels it is more important to communicate on a more regular basis instead of giving his report every meeting.

<u>General Business</u>; A Code of Practice was drawn up for anyone who is driving the truck. It is now in the truck. Ron McKiernan suggested that maybe we have three drivers next year instead of two. One could be resting while the other two go to the race on alternate weeks.
