Reason for South Coast Pigeon Federation (SCF) Special General Meeting

Purpose of the Meeting is to decide whether to suspend racing for two weeks or to continue racing the 2023 SCF Racing Season as per the schedule. The SCF Committee recommended that racing be suspended due to many SCF Flyers' lofts reporting the Rota Virus and poor returns from the first three (3) races.

Meeting Discussion: Young pigeons have caught Rota, some pigeons are more susceptible as they in-bred. Some members thought it was a good idea to make Rota Vaccination mandatory. Someone suggested putting the pigeons together a month before racing. The loss of pigeons is often because we are racing from the north. The birds need to be educated by flyers tossing and the Federation tossing the birds. Unfortunately we have not had many SCF tosses this year as we were waiting on the new truck to be ready.

- For suspension of racing for 2 weeks: 20 + 4 proxy votes
- Against suspending racing for 2 weeks: 12

Outcome: The SCF 2023 Racing will be suspended for two (2) weekends, recommencing Racing on Saturday, 1 July 2023, with the 1st Caves Beach.
