Launceston still have an issue with the DPI in regards to housing the pigeons in a loft down there. Looking into costing for driving the birds down.

Need to update the Liberators SOP to reflect what needs to be done. Things to add in

- Check fans working before loading of birds
- Ensure water trays are turned over before baskets go on.
- Ensure water trays are turned over after baskets are removed.
- Check Temp gauges are working.
- When internal gauge is 20c than fan to be turned on.
- Rear door of truck to be left open & the Grill door locked to create ventilation when the truck is either parked at Motel / Hotel & liberation spot.

Kidzwish, the committee have sent out 140 letters and have \$\$ coming in already.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

• Paul asked that all bird transfers be done by 1st race as per race rule.29.

As Paul stated would be a shame if someone won a race and where disqualified due to not transferring the rings number.

- Could clubs please transfer breeders plate birds to RING Sec ASAP.
- Out of area ring transfers incur a 40c administration fee.
- Paul needs the specific ring numbers of those that have been used.
