  - 43a. All transfers must be in writing on the approved SCF Inc. of NSW Transfer form and signed by both the breeder and flyer/owner by the first main series race of the year.
  - 43b. All Out of Area IGBF flyers are to use the SCF Inc. of NSW Transfer form to register birds. This form must be signed by both the breeder and flyer/owner.
  - 43c. All rings must be registered in the flyers name with the SCF Inc. of NSW Ring Secretary prior to the commencement of the SCF Inc. of NSW Racing Season.

**Stray Pigeon:** Alec has had a pigeon reported in Melbourne SCF 2019 26, however, he cannot find any record of any pigeons with that number.

**SCF Truck:** Steve spoke with Mick Marciano today regarding the leaking in the middle of the water tank. Marciano's will fix the tank.

**Racing Pointscores:** People are sending pigeons to the National race this week to maintain their position in the pointscore. Pointscore is currently the best average across the year, however, it could be changed to the top 20 flyers, so people are not compelled to fly. There was discussion about when do we not race?

ACTION 10.6: SCF Committee to move a Motion at the AGM 2024 – Pointscore, if there are less than 25% of SCF Members competing in a Race, the Race will not accrue Pointscore Points.

ACTION 10.7: SCF Committee to move a Motion at the AGM 2024 – Pointscore, that only the top 20 flyers each week will accrue points in the Weekly SCF Pointscore. This will mean that the CURRENT **SCF Racing By-Law 2023 Number 47, 48a, 48b, 48c** as shown below will need to be replaced:

- 47. The Weekly SCF Pointscore system to be determined by the following allocation of points: Flyers are awarded points corresponding to their actual finishing position in that Federation Race.
  - 48a. Flyers not flying that SCF Race are awarded the corresponding points for the maximum number of SCF flyers for that season.
  - 48b. Flyers not clocking in a SCF Race are awarded the corresponding points for the maximum number of flyers in that SCF Race.
  - 48c. Positions are determined with the lowest points the winner.

#### The NEW/REPLACMENT SCF Racing By-Law 2023 Number 47, 47a, 47b, 47c to read as per the following:

47. The Weekly SCF Pointscore system to be determined by the following allocation of points:

The top 20 flyers are awarded points corresponding to their actual finishing position in that Federation Race.

- 47a. Flyers not flying that SCF Race will not be awarded any points.
- 47b. Flyers not clocking in an SCF Race are not awarded any points.
- 47c. Positions are determined with the highest points to the winner ie
  - 1<sup>st</sup> = 20 points
  - $2^{nd}$  = 19 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> = 18 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> = 17 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> = 16 points
  - 6<sup>th</sup> = 15 points

2024 RACING SEASON: Steve presented a number of graphs from multiple federations from NSW, Qld, and Vic.

There was discussion regarding 3 calls for nominations next year, refine racing for next year to have a sprint series, a middle series, and a long series.

The National is on the schedule and can be raced if there is enough interest. The Grand Prix and the Soldiers' Plate has been cancelled as there has not been enough interest.

The SCF Committee has received numerous calls from concerned members over the last few weeks because they have had poor returns from the longer races, and they did not wish to fly the Northern Racing Route during 2024.

ACTION 10.8: A Special General Meeting needs to be organised following the numerous calls from concerned members and the letter from Shellies-Lake. It was proposed that a Special Meeting could be held on Friday, 6 October 2023 at Warilla as members will be meeting for the National Loft Auction that night.
