Correspondence Received

- Brent Cavill had approached B Hider to see if they would reduce his ban from 5 years to 2 years. It was proposed that Brent appears before the Committee Meeting in January 2022. The members would also need to vote on Brent being accepted back in earlier than the 5 year ban. B Hider will ask Brent to write a letter with an apology to the Committee and come to the January 2022 Committee Meeting.

Treasurer report:

- The IMB Bank has changed from Westpac bank to the ANZ bank for their cheque books from 1 June 2021. All cheques in our current cheque book must be cashed before the end of May 2021 and all existing blank cheques are to be destroyed. The only outstanding cheque in the current cheque book is 26408467 to D Armstrong for \$47.00. D Armstrong requested that this cheque be cancelled and an EFT direct debit be raised. Treasurer's Report accepted by L KrKovski and seconded by P Clarke.

General Business

1. DM raised a point about the minutes of the Special Meeting regarding the motion moved by Wayne Gallagher and Micko Thompson:

"If we cannot race into Victoria, we stay on the South route and race from a point as close as possible to the border until it reopens."

It was queried as to whether it was only for 2 weeks but it was decided that the Wayne Gallagher and Micko Thompson motion would stand as shown above. In the event of a long-term border closure, any variation to this plan would need to be determined by the SCF racing members.

- 2. DM used the Visa Card to purchase fuel and lunch when the trailer was picked up from Nowra. DM has also purchased pesticide to fumigate the truck as it had been infested with spiders.
- 3. DA had 70 Race Schedules printed and laminated. The Race Schedules were distributed to all the clubs and flyers at this meeting.
- 4. DA to invite Jenny to go on the tosses with Robert.
- 5. \$5 per basket nominated for the SCF Truck Tosses whether you toss or not, up to club secretaries to collect the money and advise DA by Wednesday, 12 May 2021 for the first toss and race nominations are to be received by 16 May 2021. The second toss nominations need to be received by 19 May 2021. There is a minimum of 50 baskets per toss or members will be charged \$10 per basket to cover charges. Only members who have nominated will be allowed to toss.

PC is happy to run a toss on the trailer, mid-week and/or Sundays. Baskets will need to be cleaned after the trailer tosses. Trailer tossing days and nominations of basket numbers will be determined later. Trailer tosses will be \$5 per basket. 30 baskets can fit on the trailer with a maximum of \$150 to go to fuel, lunch and the long-distance committee. Clubs to contact PC if they wish to toss on the trailer.

MS asked if Shellies could load on a Saturday morning instead of a Friday night for tosses. LK also wanted to have basketing on Saturday mornings for the guys that can't make it on a Friday night for tosses. It was decided after discussion that the Friday night basketing remain as this will be good practice for Friday night basketing for Racing.

- Trevor was contacted by Ron Beattie from Nowra regarding racing with SCF. Both Ron Beattie and Tom Watson will be charged 80 cents per bird with basketing at the Shellies Club from Moruya onwards. An annual truck levy of \$100 each will also be charged.
- 7. PC picked up 30 baskets yesterday from Nowra. Can someone help PC to take the baskets off the trailer and modify them? There are 5 racing baskets available for sale at PCs for \$40 per basket
- 8. DL to organise the Telstra Sim Card for the camera on the truck.

9. JS asked if the truck driver had a GPS system. Robert stated he has a Tom-Tom. DL will run through the GPS with Robert the truck driver.
