BENZING LIVE - LETTER FROM RICHARD WHITEHEAD AND JEFF HENDERSON

After reviewing Richard and Jeff's letter that they can use the Benzing Live system even though the ballots may have voted not to use this system due to health reasons, the committee has decided that Richard can use the Benzing live for club races to be used according to club rules.

LETTER FROM WOONONA-BULLI PIGEON CLUB

Woonona/Bulli has written a letter regarding their concerns about the J&M 5% pigeon mix being used on the SCF truck and the 2025 AGM Motion 2.

Woonona-Bulli Pigeon Club have concerns regarding the quality of the J & J pigeon food having weevils, but it is also noted that there are also concerns with other brands of pigeon food having weevils at this time of year.

The committee has decided that the J&M 5% mix will be quality tested before we use it on the truck. If the food isn't up to standard, we will use an equivalent mix.

The committee will also supply a storage bin for the excess feed to be placed in and disposed of so that it will not be tipped back into the storage bin with the fresh feed eliminating any contamination. The committee will also advise the truck driver and liberator of the correct feeding practices of the birds on the truck.

Woonona–Bulli also commented on Motion 2 from the AGM Woonona-Bulli feel that the intent of Motion 2 is already covered by the practices set up in 2008 whereby the SCF racing costs were separated into fixed and variable costs.

Motion 2 was voted in by the SCF members and will cover the fixed costs and two variable costs, which will be the cost of the fuel and maintenance for the truck.
