To the Members of the SCF Committee,

REGARDING: 2018 \$10 RING RACE.,

As a result, due to not racing last season and with the possibility of the Rota Virus infecting birds,

The Long-Distance Committee after much discussion and consideration, have decided that to achieve the best results for both the race and flyers, the 2018 Ring Race should run as follows:

- Rather than order rings (not knowing how many flyers would be interested), flyers nominate their own \$10 race pigeons instead.
- However instead of flyers nominating before breeding, flyers breed and ring pigeons with this year's rings that they have already purchased for the upcoming season. This will allow flyers to pick pigeons that are well homed and are the best breeds going. Making this a fantastic race for all that enter.
- There is no limit of entries per flyer.
- All birds are to be young birds with this year's rings.
- To be eligible to enter the race, flyers are to nominate the \$10 ring race pigeons on the first basketing night of the 2018 season
- Distance of the race will remain the same.
- Same percentage of prize money will be allocated.
- All money due is to be paid for by cheque, from the club which the flyer is a member of, on the first basketing night of the season.
- All clubs are to forward nominations and money from their members to Paul Barnes at Towradgi Pigeon Club.

Bird nominations and money must be forwarded onto Paul Barnes on the first basketing night of the season and no later.
