30b,30c

to enable any member of that club to have his combine race birds rung and basketed in their
respective club.

30b. Should there not be three members of a club competing in a club race; a member of that
club must take his combine race birds to the nearest club for ringing and basketing.

30c. There must be three members in a club competing with continuous running clocks or
ETS before any member can have his clock set or checked in their respective clubroom to
compete in any race controlled by the SCF Inc. of NSW.
