COVID-19 Pigeon Club Safe Operating Procedure

- **Extra measures that would help if put in place to prevent the spread of Covid-19 vires**
- Keep social distancing rules 1.5 metres apart
- Better hygiene, wash hands or use hand sanitizer
- Use PPE if needed once risk assessed
- Do not eat or drink in club
- Do not share any implements or tools with other members
- Close canteens
- Refrain from hanging around if not needed to keep the club operational
- Have a dedicated person or persons to collect the clocks after the race from Vulnerable flyers
- Put a risk assessment in place for cleaning the returned race baskets
- Travel alone in your own vehicle
- Best if a pre-arranged time could be agreed for your basketing slot
- Stay in your own car until club official has signalled you to bring your birds into the club house for basketing
- A dedicated team from the youngest/fittest members should basket and do clocks
- **Do not come to club if members have any signs of cold or flu like symptoms**

Each club is responsible for their own PPE
