Dear Editor,

I recently read your article about the results from the Parkes One Loft Race 2025 and the claims made regarding the non-existence of racing pigeon organisations in the Moruya and surrounding areas — thereby suggesting that there was nowhere for Bruce King and Neil Williams to race their pigeons.

This is factually incorrect. The South East Racing Pigeon Combine Inc., a small but active organisation, operates in that very area. In fact, it was formerly known as the Moruya Racing Pigeon Club, of which both King and Williams were members. The results of their participation in pigeon racing can be found on [pigeonrace.net](http://pigeonrace.net) — under the Shoalhaven Pigeon Federation up to 2018, then under the South East Racing Pigeon Combine from 2019 onwards, and again under the Shoalhaven Pigeon Federation from 2021 through to 2023 inclusive.

Your readers deserve accurate information, particularly when they are investing both time and money to race pigeons bred by others. Information presented should be factual and transparent. Unfortunately, the article's statement regarding the absence of racing opportunities in the Moruya region is demonstrably false.

The performance of the birds being offered can easily be verified by reviewing the published results on [pigeonrace.net](http://pigeonrace.net) for the organisations mentioned above. I am not suggesting that the birds are of poor quality or unworthy of consideration. However, sound decisions can only be made when based on honest and verifiable information.

A lack of transparency and factual accuracy only serves to undermine confidence and contributes to the decline of our beloved sport.

Dear Doug,

As you know the South East Racing Pigeon Combine Inc is located on the far south coast of New South Wales with its small membership ranging from Batemans Bay in the north and Tathra in the south.

Our small combine does struggle to get its pigeons away for racing without the assistance of neighbouring racing pigeon federations and combines. When flying south we rely on the South Coast Federation to transport our birds beyond the 300 km race point being Lakes Entrance onwards. We have done this in partnership with the SCF without any issues at all abiding by their rules and protocols for the liberation and racing of our pigeons.

In 2026 the SCF is racing north which will make it impossible for SERPC to get on board with them for racing as they start in early June and will be too far up the track to realistically catch them.

SERPC would like to join the Canberra Combine in 2026 and beyond to race our pigeons. We will conduct our early racing on our own and time our schedule to coincide with your third race point of your race schedule, if that is possible.

By possible we mean the Canberra Combine will allow the SERPC membership to send their pigeons on the Canberra Combine truck from their 3rd race point onwards.

SERPC will have a maximum of 6 members and will abide by any conditions and bird limits imposed by the Canberra Combine.

SERPC will pay whatever reasonable costs that the Canberra Combine ask of us for the transport, care and liberation of our race birds.

SERPC inclusion will not do anything to jeopardize the normal and orderly running of the Canberra Combine.

The future of racing pigeons on the far south coast of NSW is honestly reliant on our larger neighbouring federations and combines. We ask that the Canberra Combine please give this request serious consideration and allow the SERPC membership to send race pigeons with you in 2026 from your 3rd race point onwards.

Looking forward to a favourable response and a bright future for pigeon racing on the far south coast of NSW with the assistance of the Canberra Racing Pigeon Combine.

Hi Manny,

Murray Woods here - secretary of the CRPC.

I just wanted to touch base regarding your request around transport you sent to Doug in August following a meeting of the CRPC Executive last night.

We have in principle agreement from the Executive to transport your birds next year from the third racepoint on as requested. We still have a bit to do in terms of logistics, but we just wanted to let you know of the outcome and inform you of the next steps.

- Our 2026 race program is still to be sorted, but we will be flying north to Lightning Ridge/St George/Roma. We will meet next month to finalise the schedule, and once that is done we will get you a copy so you can start to work out your own schedule
- We are happy to accept week by week payments from participating members rather than an up front fee. This should hopefully give you guys some flexibility. We will inform you of the fees early in the new year when we do our fee calculations
- Closer to the time, we will need to discuss the week to week logistics of getting your birds on the truck so our Senior Basketing Official can have things ready to go

In the meantime, if there is anything you need feel free to get in touch with either Doug or myself. Otherwise we will get you more information as we sort it out.
