Bird Limits & Surplus.

3. SURPLUS BASKETS & BIRD LIMITS

1. The SERPC Inc. will vote on a bird limit for the coming race season when life rings are ordered for that coming race season.

Motion One:

The bird limit for SERPC reverts to what existed in 2023 being.

The bird limit for any race conducted by the South East Racing Pigeon Combine shall be determined by.

1. The number of fliers
2. The period of confinement (overnight or longer)
3. The space available in the club's transport in accordance with the recommendations made by the Australian National Racing Pigeon Board for the transport of racing pigeons.

The bird limit for any racing participated in by the South East Racing Pigeon Combine when the transporting federation or combine is not the South East Racing Pigeon Combine will be whatever that transporting federation or combine determines.

SURPLUS BASKETS & BIRD LIMITS

1. The bird limit for any race conducted by the South East Racing Pigeon Combine Inc. shall be 45.
2. Surplus birds will be permitted. Surplus liberation will be at least 30 minutes before or after the race birds have been liberated. Before or after will be at the discretion of the Liberator on that day. There will be no costs incurred by members who send surplus birds.
3. Toss birds will be permitted from the second race point onwards. The location of that liberation will be the first race point of the schedule for that year. Toss birds will be liberated on the return trip after race and surplus birds have been liberated. There will be no costs for members who send toss birds.
4. Numbers of surplus and toss birds will be determined by space availability in accordance with the recommendations made by the Australian National Racing Pigeon Board for the transport of racing pigeons.
