GENERAL BUSINESS

A Greenburg – Flying status

Alan asked if he could race with SPF as a member of N & D IPC in 2020 or as an independent: Members of NDIPC were in favour of Alan racing with them. Alan thanked the members

Intention of other financial SPF Members re 2020 season

Questions were raised as to the intentions of P Barrett & G Matthews with regarding who they intend to fly with in 2020. At this stage no one was 100% sure what they were doing.

PMV & ROTA Vaccination

Discussion ensued about making vaccination compulsory for both PMV & ROTA if members wish to race with the SPF.

Steve B moved that - Vaccination for both PMV & ROTA for race & stock birds be compulsory if members wish to race with the SPF. 2nd A Greenburg - passed unopposed.

Alan asked about the possibility of a SPF honour board being installed on a white board. To be looked into & discussed at a later date.

Ring Issue

Due to running out of 2019 life rings the ring secretary was advised by executive to use 2016, 2017 & 2018 unallocated rings. The numerical sequence recorded and these rung birds will be treated as YBs for SPF & club events. All in favour.

Federation membership

Jeff raised the issue of 'SPF member' means being up for a shared proportion of the federations fixed costs per year. He outlined that the \$10 fee was basically a down payment. To keep the federation viable and financial all members need to share the fixed running costs per season whether flying or not. Flying fees will be allocated on a yearly basis depending on variable costs. Discussion ensued and members were in favour.

Truck situation

Once again the executive was asked to sell the truck. Jeff explained that we have had interest from G Bosco Liverpool & Charlie Grech from WPF Victoria. Both were provided with all details, photos and copies of paperwork. These both ended in a no sale. Executive will continue to pursue a buyer. Leanne offered to advertise truck on various websites.
